Building A Resilient Workforce

Annually at the holidays, the Executive Construction Foundation donates to a non-profit organization to enhance their programs. This year, we broadened the reach of the Foundation; going beyond charitable giving to reinvest in the future workforce of the construction industry. In concert with the non-profit **Resilient**, and the Construction Industry Service Corporation (CISCO), **we've partnered on an apprenticeship pipeline program—Project UPSTART—that showcases construction trades as a viable career path for high school students.** With a goal to raise awareness of the value of the trades, the program will include informational school assemblies and hands-on demonstrations that pique students interests, and, ultimately, trade firms' apprentice sponsorships and on-going mentorship. As a partner to this initiative, we also **donated seed funds to Resilient that will support initial costs as the program launches**, such as outreach communications.



Resilient provides support and mentorship to hundreds of at-risk kids in the Roosevelt Road Corridor in DuPage County. Their programs **impact marginalized youth, ages 5-20 years old, to foster the development of upstanding character, life skills, independence and self-empowerment.** Additionally, they support their families and larger community to create a stronger foundation for these children and young adults to encourage greater potential success.
